### Editing Team - 2021 C&P Edited Book

The Curriculum and Pedagogy Group (C&P) invites proposals for the 2021 Curriculum and Pedagogy Edited Book. The selected editors will be responsible for soliciting, reviewing, and editing manuscripts for the 13th edited book.

We are looking for proposals aligned with C&P's purpose and mission supporting diversity and seeking ways to integrate, interrogate, and develop theories and practices for educational change and social justice. "Valuing and developing conceptual and applied/practical research, C&P has historically honored and continues to honor a range of practice orientations and commitments as a means for interrogating both theory and practice in ways that continually ask: *what is to be done both in research and scholarship and for the practice of teaching and learning?*"

#### **Proposal Requirements:**

##### **Team Membership**

We encourage an editing team of two to four people, preferably with inter-institutional representation. This team is to include at least one member with an established publication record and experience in the process of editing, and a combination of members, including faculty, students, and practitioners. The leading team member will work directly with the C&P Publications Committee and the publishing company.

The editing team will be responsible for setting the book's timeline, calling for chapter proposals, coordinating academic feedback, establishing the editing process, and meeting the publisher's requirements.

##### **Vision Statement for the Project**

We seek proposals with a vision statement indicating how you intend to produce a coherent and well-integrated voice, organization, and style throughout the volume.

The team should consider the following questions:

What are the main themes and topics to be included in the proposed edited book?

How will non-traditional submissions be solicited and supported?

##### **Suggested Proposal Format**

Tentative book title

Purpose/Topic of the book

Description of team roles, including institutional support and brief bios

Call for chapter proposals dissemination plan

Tentative timeline
